The grandeur and beauty of Angkor has to be seen to be believed. This centre of ancient Khmer civilization will captivate your heart and soul.

Day 1: Siem Reap

We'll meet you at the airport and take you to the hotel to settle in and have lunch. Then it's time to see one of the world's most breathtaking sights. The temples of Angkor. See the jungle-covered ruins of Ta Prohm before heading to the magnificence of Angkor Wat with its stunning carvings. Then we take our place at Phnom Bakheng to watch the sunset over this magnificent temple. (L/D)

Day 2: Siem Reap

This morning we return, entering through the Southern Gate of the fortified city of Angkor Thom. Marvel at the carved faces of Bayon. Walk the Elephant Terrace and admire the Terrace of the Leper King. After lunch we return to the Grand and Small Circuit to see sights including Pre Rup, Mebon, Ta Som, Neak Pean, Prah Khan and Terrace of Srah Srang. It's a big day that finishes with a blissful traditional foot massage. (B/L/D)

Day 3: Siem Reap

A free morning to relax by the pool or hit the markets before being taken to the airport for your flight. (B)

One of Asia's best kept secrets, Laos' slow pace, smiling hospitality and streets lined with ancient temples and echoes of the past is endlessly fascinating.

Day 1: Vientiane

We'll meet you and take you to your hotel before hitting the town. Wonder at thousands of miniature Buddhas in the oldest temple, Wat Sisaket, the stunning golden stupas of sacred Wat Pha That Luang and the former royal temple of Wat Prakeo. We also visit Patuxai, Laos' own Arc de Triomphe. You're then free until dinner and a traditional Laos dance performance. (D)

Day 2: Vientiane – Luang Prabang

We fly to magical Luang Prabang and start exploring the town's beautiful wats, including Wat Visoun, before climbing the stairs to the top of Mount Phousi to watch the sun set over the Mekong. We hit the night street market

for handicrafts made by local and hilltribe people before dinner. (B/L/D)

Day 3: Luang Prabang

Admire the town's oldest temple, Wat Sene, and the classical Laos architecture of Wat Xieng Thong. Then it's a short boat ride to the wondrous sight of hundreds of miniature Buddha statues at the Pak Ou Caves and a stop at a rice-wine making village. Later we drive to the village of Ban Phanom, known for its silk weaving. The evening's free and the local food delicious, so enjoy. (B/L)

Day 4: Luang Prabang

If you're up at dawn step out to see the daily ritual of saffron-robed monks receiving alms from the locals. After breakfast we visit the museum in the former Royal Palace, then bargain for the rare and unusual at the Phousi Market. There's some free time before we take you to the airport for your afternoon flight. (B)
